



- A. **Johnny Jordaan Plein, Elandsgracht 1.** A square named after a famous Amsterdam folk singer. Visit your first “bruin café” at Café Eland on the corner.
- B. **Pancakes Amsterdam, Berenstraat 38.** Best pancakes in town. Opens at 10 so come early to avoid the queue.
- C. **Bar Wolvenstraat, Wolvenstraat 23.** A hip bar for the Amsterdam in-crowd, with some bites to eat as well.
- D. **Gamekeeper, Hartenstraat 14.** Need a card or a boardgame to pass time? This store has it all, in both Dutch and English. Owner of this place knows them all and gives expert advice.
- E. **Resturant Nooch, Reestraat 11.** Modern Asian kitchen with excellent chefs and good service.
- F. **Westerkerk church, Prinsengracht 281.** A magnificent cathedral from 1631. During summer months climb the tower for a view over the city. On Easter Friday join the impressive Johannes Passion (free entry).
- G. **Bar De Vergulde Gaper & De 2 Prinsen, Prinsenstraat 30.** Two popular bars at a canal street corner, with outdoor seating. A great place to stop and watch the locals biking past.
- H. **Noorderkerk church, Noordermarkt 48.** Another classic Amsterdam church on a square with several bars and restaurants.
- I. **Bar Tabac, Brouwersgracht 101.** A very popular bar with a great view over two canals. The summer crowd extends the bar over the whole street corner.
- J. **Restaurant Nevy, Westerdoksdijk 40.** A classy seafood restaurant with a view over the IJ river.
- K. **Restaurant I-Dock, Ijdok 4.** A restaurant at the newest hotel in Amsterdam. By the water on a manmade island.
- L. **Ferry terminal, behind the central station.** Free ferries connect the city with the north side, an old industrial part of Amsterdam worth its own tour. The best one goes to NDSM-werf with several cool bars and restaurants waiting for you.
- M. **Bimhuis, Piet Heinkade 3.** The best sunset spot in Amsterdam. Restaurant Zouthaven is also here with a large terrace.
- N. **Bar Hanneke’s Boom, Dijksgracht 4.** A very popular bar/restaurant during the summer, with a large outdoor area by the water.
- O. **Amsterdam Public Library, Oosterdoksade 143.** The newly built libary building with a couple of restaurants too.
- P. **Skylounge, Oosterdoksstraat 4.** Amazing views over Amsterdam from this chic rooftop bar.
- Q. **Chinatown.** Chinese supermarkets and resturants.
- R. **Nieuwmarkt.** Several bars and restaurants, great mojitos and atmosphere at Cuba Café.
